Congratulations! On behalf of the faculty in Electrical Engineering and Computer Science, we are pleased to offer you graduate admission to the University of California, Irvine beginning Fall 2014 for the purpose of graduate study leading to the Doctor of Philosophy degree in Computer Engineering. Your UC Irvine student identification number is 10486578. Your offer is based on your outstanding academic record and your promise as a future scholar.

In addition, you have been selected to be a department fellow. This is a competitive award and includes financial support offered to the most outstanding applicants in the department. Your award is for a total of 6 quarters, covering the first two academic years, starting with Fall 2014. The total amount of support offered through the fellowship over the first two academic years is approximately \$95,789. The support consists of approximately \$1,915. per month stipend, plus funds to cover all tuition, fees and health insurance for the nine months of each academic year. We encourage you to get involved in research as soon as you can, and the financial support we are offering is intended to facilitate this. You have the freedom to choose any thesis advisor who is willing to work with you. You are encouraged to explore your options by browsing through the faculty research webpages and contacting the faculty members.

Note that the financial offer described above is subject to your satisfactory performance and timely progress towards your degree over this period. If you wish to accept this offer, please let us know via email, to [eecsgrad@uci.edu](mailto:eecsgrad@uci.edu), by April 15, 2014.

Your admission status is provisional. You must forward an official copy of your final graduate transcripts to the UC Irvine Engineering Graduate Affairs Office to verify the completion of your master's degree. You will want to clear this provision at your earliest convenience, if you have not already done so, in order that it does not interfere with your enrollment for the Fall 2014 academic term.

Your initial faculty contact is Professor Fadi Kurdahi. Your faculty contact can answer questions about the content of courses offered at UC Irvine. Your faculty contact may or may not become your thesis advisor; you will find an official thesis advisor after enrolling at UC Irvine. While we do not pay for housing, the University of California, Irvine guarantees an offer of on-campus housing to newly admitted Fall 2014 PhD students. Housing offers will be for one of six graduate housing communities and must be accepted prior to the first day of classes. Eligibility for housing extends until the normative time to degree for your academic program. Further information will be sent to you in a separate email in the next few days. You can apply for on-campus housing beginning March 1, 2014. Please be sure to observe the deadline for this application, as late requests are not honored.

Additionally, should you decide to attend our School, in order to receive your I-20 you must submit the New Graduate Student Visa Document Request form available online at <http://www.ic.uci.edu/Students/New/I-20orDS-2019.php>. Please carefully follow the instructions and return your completed paperwork as well as a copy of your passport biography page to Amy Pham. You should expect to receive an e-mail note from the UC Irvine Graduate Division within the next two weeks asking you to complete an on-line Statement of Intent to Register (SIR). Please be sure to submit your SIR by the requested SIR deadline of April 15, 2014. Congratulations again on your admission to our school.
